STUDYING WITH ACCA - VARIOUS ENTRY OPTIONS

No formal qualification



If you have no formal qualifications, you can begin the ACCA qualification by enrolling in Diploma in Accounting and Business.

Completed Schooling



To begin studying ACCA, you must have any one of the following:

- Two A Levels and three GCSEs (or their equivalent)
These need to be in five separate subjects including English and Mathematics OR
- If you hold any of the following certificates providing passes are held in 5 subjects (at least 3 in Year XII) including English and Mathematics / Accounts, mark of 65% in at least 2 subjects and over 50% on the others:
 - India School Certificate
 - Intermediate Certificate
 - Higher School Certificate
 - Higher Secondary Certificate
 - All India Senior School Certificate
 - Pre-University Course

Completed Undergraduate / Post Graduate / Other Professional Qualification



If you have completed your bachelors, masters or hold qualification from other bodies, then you will be entitled to exemptions. To check how many exemptions you can claim, please click on the link below and enter your institute name. Follow the steps thereafter to find out your exemptions. However, please note that until you are registered with ACCA as a student the exemptions will not be finalized or reflected on your account. www.accaglobal.com/exemptions

INDIAN CAs

If you are an Indian CA since May 2003 or a passed finalist then you are exempted from 9 papers out of the 14 in the ACCA qualification. You are directly eligible to begin your ACCA qualification at the professional level and progress to your ACCA membership through just 5 papers.

If you are an IPCC cleared student, you get eligible to get 5 papers (F1, F2, F3, F6 & F8)

WHY SHOULD INDIAN CAs STUDY ACCA?

The ACCA qualification helps Indian CA's in the following ways:

International recognition – Indian CAs also studying the ACCA qualification broadens their career options. As an ACCA member, they are able to undertake more diverse roles, work in more diverse industries as well as work with multinational organizations that require expertise of finance professionals who are trained with international standards.

Flexibility – an Indian ACCA needs to give only 5 papers (professional level) of The ACCA Qualification in order to gain their ACCA membership. The CA articleship counts towards the ACCA Practical Experience Requirement (PER).

Exams - exams are not held in groups. You will only reappear for modules you haven't cleared when appearing for ACCA exams.



WHAT'S INVOLVED

To achieve the ACCA Qualification, student will need to complete exams, an ethics module and practical experience.

EXAMS

Student needs to complete 14 exams in total. A maximum of nine exams in the Fundamentals level are available for exemption.

ETHICS

A Professional Ethics module designed to give you exposure to a range of ethical perspectives to develop your ethical knowledge. It's important to ACCA that you know how to behave ethically and professionally. This module should be completed before, at the same time as or soon after completing Paper P1, Governance, Risk and Ethics.

EXPERIENCE

You will need to complete three years' relevant practical experience and achieve 13 performance objectives. This will help you to demonstrate to potential employers that you can apply your knowledge to the workplace and are ready for business. You can achieve your work experience before, at the same time as or after completing your exams. Ideally, at the same time is best.

COLLECT QUALIFICATIONS ALONG THE WAY

As you study and train for the ACCA Qualification, there are lots of qualifications you can achieve along the way as you progress towards ACCA membership. This is a great way to demonstrate to employers the knowledge and skills you have acquired and helps keep you on track and motivated.








FOUNDATIONS IN PROFESIONALISM
An online ethics module to be completed to achieve a certificate for Foundation level



THE PROFESSIONAL ETHICS MODULE
An online ethics module which must be completed before, at the same time, or soon after you become eligible to sit Paper P1. You also need to complete this to achieve Advanced Diploma in Accounting and Business and the BSc Degree awarded by Oxford Brookes University.

EXPERIENCE
36 months relevant work experience is required and can be completed before, at the same time, or after the exams.

The ACCA Qualification is divided into two levels – Fundamentals and Professional level. If you meet our minimum entry requirement which is 10+2 / India School Certificate / Intermediate Certificate / Higher School Certificate / Higher Secondary Certificate / Pre-University Course – you can start at the Fundamentals level. There are lots of qualifications you can achieve along the way as you work towards ACCA membership, including a Diploma in Accounting and Business, Advanced Diploma in Accounting and Business and even a BSc degree in Applied Accounting, awarded by Oxford Brookes University.

Foundation level

You can start your ACCA journey at the Diploma in Accounting and Business. You can then transfer to the ACCA Qualification and start at F4 of the Fundamentals level.

Experience



Ethics


